- (5) Road guides and area security of the DAF - 4th MP Platoon
- (6) Each lettered Co provide two HI for detail to DACO at DAF. NCO provided by this HQ to supervise rigging and palletize
- (7) Btry B 42d A also supplies ten man detail and one NCO upon arrival at DAF
- (8) Chalk commanders report to DACO upon arrival at DAF with chalk status and one copy of each individual shoe tag
- (9) All personnel remain within preparation area and at no time proceed within 10 meters of runway. Chalk CO's responsible for accountability of personnel
- (10) DACO will direct all loading of aircraft
- (11) Vehicles and pallets will be loaded before PAX board aircraft
- (12) Troops turn-in "shoe tag" to designated individual as they board aircraft
- (13) Shoe tags will be prepared by personnel as follows:

- (15) Make certain all loads are secured in vehicles - bracings and tie-downs will be used as required
- (16) Vehicles fuel tanks and gas cans will be 3/4 full when loaded on aircraft
- (17) All conex containers and vehicles will be marked with their chalk
- (14) Vehicles and trailers will be reduced to the lowest possible dimensions to facilitate loading and unloading. Remove top covers and store securely in the vehicle. Fold rear-view mirror, tailgates, windshields, antennas and similar equipment
