SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 156 for 080001H Apr to 082400H Apr 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12 Inf remains OPCON to 4th Inf Div, operating from CAMP RADCLIFF.

(1) 1/A and 81mm mortar section OPCON to B Co, displaced by air to LZ vic 422162. A Co(-) cont care and cleaning of equip and provides 2 platoons for security of the 4th Avn Bn. Hawkeye 22 and 1/A observed 10 new hootches vic 426166. Grid was passed to A Co 81mm mortars as a target. 1/A and 81mm's return to RADCLIFF.

(2) B Co conducts air assault vic grid 417137 then begins search and destroy mission around the LZ. B Co diverted to LZ CHALLENGE to aid Recon 2/35 in contact NE of FSB NIAGARA.

(3) C Co conducts air lift from grid vic 486639 to CAMP RADCLIFF, begin maintenance and cleaning of equip. CA postponed due to lack of air assets. 2/C 200m NW of 486639 observed and engaged with S/A 1 indiv wearing camouflaged fatigues. Neg results, indiv fled to the N.

(4) D Co remains OPCON to 1/10 Cav.

(5) Recon OPCON to B Co to provide security for hipshoot vic 422162. Move to hipshoot location by air assault. Returned to CAMP RADCLIFF upon cancellation of mission.

(6) 4.2" mortars OPCON to B Co to establish hipshoot vic 422162. Returned to CAMP RADCLIFF after change of mission received.
