SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 177 for 290001H Apr to 292400H Apr 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12 Inf remains OPCON to 4th Inf Div operating out of FSB AQUARIUS; providing security for D-4th Engineers.

(1) Co A provides FSB security and conducts fire base construction.

(2) Co B remains at CAMP RADCLIFF as Golf Course security.

(3) C Co OPCON 1/10 Cav.

(4) Co D cont RIF and ambush opns; vic 436617 found what is believed to have been abandoned LRP position. In area were 3 ponchos, 3 poncho liners; 1 CS grenade; 1 red star cluster, 4 claymores with detonator, (claymores blown).

(5) Recon vic 468617 spotted 2 individuals, engaged with S/A; no return fire received. A sweep of the SEL revealed neg findings. Vic 471619 a hootch was found, 12x10x6', with fire place. There were 3 baskets, one filled with tobacco others empty. Also a bunker, last use 72H, by estimated 5 indiv.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb 70:

US losses: 37 WIA; 4 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 15 enemy KIA (BC), 4 field phones, 4 switchboards, 3 radios CIA; 9 S/A CIA; 86,570 lbs rice CIA.
