SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 178 for 300001H Apr to 302400H Apr 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf remained OPCON to the 4th Inf Div, operating out of FSB AQUARIUS, providing security for D-4th Engineers.

(1) A Co continues as FSB security.

(2) B Co remains at CAMP RADCLIFF as Golf Course security.

(3) C Co OPCON 1/10 Cav. Vic BR163502 Co C had 2 enemy KIA and 1 S/A CIA; neg US casualties.

(4) D Co vic BR460624 the 2d plat found 15 hootches (10x10x8') each with a bunker (5x6x3'), with 10-12" O/H. Also found were a "Playboy" magazine, machette, 4 crossbows; corn; bananas; papaya; 1 water container; tobacco; GI helmet liner; can bug spray; US axe; 20-30 pigs and 3-4 chickens; and 1 Chicom grenade. Area large enough for 75-100 people; used in past 6-7 days. Vic 463624 2/D found 2 hootches, 2x2', no sides roof only. 3 M-16 magazines with about 10 rds apiece; tobacco; cotton; yarn and a basket. Believed to be a stopover point. Vic 464623 found another hootch 3x3', roof only. Miscellaneous utensils and tobacco around. 2/D found a rice hootch, 4x4x4', vic 462620, completely full of rice, approx one ton. Destroyed.

(5) Recon vic 473633 found 18 hootches, 5x6x7', 2½' off the ground. 19 bunkers (4x3x6'), with 2' O/H, approx 6 mo to 1 year old. Neg recent use, trail 28" wide used in the last 48H running SW to NE.

US losses: 37 WIA; 4 KIA.
