Situation Report #247

Period covered: 090001 - 092400 July 1970

Reference: Map RVN, 1:50,000, Sheets 6637II, 6737III, 6737IV, 6637III.

1. Enemy: Elements of C2 407 Sapper Bn cont to operate in small 3-5 man teams and continue to maintain surveillance of friendly units in AO ODIN.

2. Own Situation:

a. Forward elements are mobile in AO. 1-12 Inf (TF NAVAJO) continued opn PUTNAM PARAGON with Bn CP located at FSB UTE (BR356708).

b. Description and results of operations:

(1) Co A operating out of temporary patrol base vic 400750 conducted platoon size patrols N, NW, and W of patrol base. 2/A vic patrol base apprehended elderly Montagnard woman. She was extracted and taken to An Khe for relocation.

(2) Co B cont construction, security, and training mission at FSB UTE (BR356708) and cont local RIF's.

(3) Co C cont construction, security, and training mission at FSB ARMAGEDDON (BR419648).

(4) Co D cont S&D and amb opns in AO bounded by 340600, 370600, 370630, 340630. 2/D vic 350614 found a spider hole 3x3x3' w/ neg recent use. Also at this location found a trail 2' wide, runnin Nw-SE, last used 1 week ago. Vic 352619, found an old village complex with 20 bunkers 6x6x4'. Est 2 yrs old with no recent use. Several hootches were in the area, but were collapsed and rotten.

(5) Recon remained on Hill 612 (BR399636) providing security for 81c(-) and radio relay conducting local RIF's and ambushes.

(6) Bulldog 25 spotted 4 hootches 4 km on a 110°AZ from FSB UTE. Artillery FO went up in a helicopter and adjusted artillery on the site and destroyed the hootches.

3. Administration: TF NAVAJO cont to be resupplied from Trains area at FSB ARMAGEDDON, (BR419648).
