SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 211 for 020001H Jun to 022400H Jun 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf cont opn PUTNAM PARAGON, working out of FSB KICMA, BR337657.

(1) A Co CA postponed to the scarcity of aircraft. A Co cont RIF and amb opns moving to the NE. Reports neg significant sightings or contacts.

(2) 2/B had moved approx 100m S of their NL(BR359599), when they received 3 rds of 60mm mortar fire from an SEL believed to be 360598. One US EM received multiple fragmentation wounds and was dusted off. R/L employed on the SEL. Gator 29 who was shuttling B Co from a PZ vic 358599 to FSB KICMA, received S/A fire of 10-20 rds on the 3rd lift, leaving the PZ. One EM on the slick received a flesh wound in the left thigh. Est 3-5 indiv in the SEL. In their night location 353603, B Co sighted 3 campfires vic 354617. R/L fired on the area.

(3) C Co remained at FSB providing local security.

(4) D Co cont RIF and amb opns moving to the NE. Reports neg significant sightings or contacts.

(5) Recon conducted RIF opns moving NW enroute to FSB KICMA. Vic 360639 found a hootch 6x8x6' est at 6 mo old, used by 2-3 indiv in the past week.

B. Cumulative results of all opns since 15 Feb:

U S losses: 50 WIA; 15 KIA.

Enemy losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 19 enemy KIA(BC), 3 VMC CIA; 21 S/A CIA; 1 82mm mortar base plate CIA; 3 radios, 4 field phones; 4 switch boards CIA 150,300 lbs rice CIA, 1000 lbs salt CIA; misc docu and equip CIA.
