SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 216 for 080001H Jun to 082400H Jun 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf conducts Bn move from AO Sunbeam to AO Sprite and begins construction of FSB CHEYENNE, (BR102731).

(1) A Co conducts CA and secures LZ, vic 101733. At 1530H after being relieved of FSB security A Co moves out on foot and begins S&D opns in area bounded by BR136738, 120700, 085690, 064738. Vic 093719, 2/A found 3 hootches ~~6x6x4~~' and a bridge. All was very old and falling down. Vic 089725 they also located 14 hootches 8x10x6' 3' off the ground, 7 had roofs and 7 did not. There were 8 bunkers also 4x4x6' 3' O/H which we dug in the side of the hill. Going in the bunkers and turning one would end up in a shelter large enough to accomodate 25-35 indiv. All 6 mo old and last used 4 mo ago.

(2) B Co maintains security of FSB KICWA and then airlifts to CHEYENNE to relieve A Co of FSB security.

(3) C Co conducts CA from PZ vic 315679 to LZ vic 120755, and begins S&D opns vic 154716, 110770, 125782, 160785. Reports neg significant findings.

(4) D Co began CA, but 1st lift was called back and D Co became OPCON to 2/8th Inf at 1300H, duration undetermined.

(5) Recon airlifts from KICWA to new FSB to begin S&D opns in area bounded by BR130738, 083738, 104764.
