SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 233 for 250001H Jun to 252400H Jun 70.

(C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf cont opn PUTNAM PARAGON from FSB ARMAGEDDON, BR421646.

(1) A Co cont FSB construction and security mission, and securing Eng working on Route 508.

(2) B Co conducts S&D opns in area bounded by 390740, 420740, 390720, 420720. The 2nd platoon located a 4 mo old hootch, (8x6x8', 2' off ground) which had been used by 4-5 indiv 1 mo ago vic 380713. The area included a PRC-25 battery, leaving apparatus and 6 rusty AK rounds.

(3) C Co cont working to the south in area defined by 350640-380640-350600-380600.

(4) D Co cont security mission of EMELLIA and Eng working to the S and N.

(5) Recon maintains security of radio relay and C Co 81mm on Hill 612.

(6) Shamrock 3 (D-1/10) working in the 1/12 AO in an area bounded by 540690, 460620, 460690, 460620 sighted several fighting positions and 2 bunkers on a L-S trail vic 476627. Area had been used 1 week ago. Vic 480630 he spotted hootches, (10x15'), 4-5 bunkers a sleeping rack and a campfire; used 2 weeks ago. At 537649, he located a fresh hootch-bunker complex. Estimate being used by a sqd size element. At 535650 sighted 1 indiv in a fresh hootchbunker complex. RP's inserted.
