SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 180 for 020001H May to 022400H May 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf chopped back to the operational control of the 2d Bde, and continues with the mission of securing D-4th Eng, out of FSB AQUARIUS.

(1) Co A begins RIF and ambush operations in area bounded by 420638, 420660, 440660, 440638. Reported neg significant sightings or contacts.

(2) Co B remains on alert status during the day as 4th Div reaction, and acts as Golf Course Pad security at night. Conduct CMMI preparations including maintenance of equipment.

(3) C Co OPCON to 1/10 Cav.

(4) Co D continues as FSB security and construction company, with 1 squad as radd block and 1 squad as water point security. 1/D secures Engineers on Hill 666, (BR398689).

(5) Recon closes on FSB AQUARIUS for brief stand down. Assist D Co with FSB security.

US losses: 37 WIA; 4 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 15 enemy KIA (BC); 9 S/A CIA; 4 switchboards, 4 field phones, and 3 radios CIA; 88,600 lbs rice CIA.
