SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 189 for 110001H May to 112400H May 70.

1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf moves from FSB INVASION, (PATTY JEAN), to FSB COMMANCHE and begins operations in assigned AO under the operational control of the 1st Bde.

(1) A Co OPCON to 1/14th, reverts back to the operational control of the 1/12th upon the arrival of the Bn(-) at FSB Comanche.

(2) Co B conducts CA to FSB COMMANCHE and begins ground ops in assigned AO. The 3d plat sighted ^{one} ~~no~~ individual wearing black PJ's and a straw hat, neg weapon, vic 574459.

(3) C Co remained in their assigned AO and became OPCON to 1/22 Inf. The 1st plat ambush vic 562475 received sniper fire. The 1st plat moved from vic 562473 to reinforce and were pinned down. Rest incomplete. The final results were: 2 NVA KIA; 1 SKS CIA; 2 US EM KIA; and 4 US EM WIA, also 1 US Heat casualty. KIA: Olsen, Verno; WIA: McDaniel, Mills, Mouton, Samsell; Heat casualty: Jordahl.

(4) Co D remained at FSB to provide security and then conducted CA to COMMANCHE to the perimeter security.

(5) Recon conducts CA to COMMANCHE and remains there.

B. Cumulative results of all ops since 15 Feb:

US losses: 41 WIA; 10 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 ~~WIA~~ WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 19 enemy KIA (BC); 19 S/A CIA; 4 Chicom field phones, 4 Chicom switchboards, 2 Chicom radios, 1 PRC-10 CIA; 120,615 lbs rice CIA, miss docu and equip CIA.
