1. (C) Operations Summary

A. The 1/12th Inf prepares to CA into their assigned AO - AO FORD.

(1) Co A Stands-by waiting on order to move to the pad.

(2) Co B stands-by, waiting to move to the pad on order.

(3) Co C, 2nd and 3rd platoons moved to the pad; CA postponed due to weather, platoons return to stand down area.

(4) Co D stands ready to move, at 1700H OPCON to IDCC for bunker security.

(5) Recon stands-by for move.

B. Cumulative results of all ops since 15 Feb:

US losses: 47 WIA; 15 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 18 enemy KIA, (BC); 19 S/A EA; 4 switchboards, 4 field phones, 3 radios CIA; 128,600 lbs rice CIA; miss docu and equip CIA.
