
National Infantry Museum & Soldier Center Announces the Dedication Ceremony of the 12th Infantry Regiment Monument

Fort Benning, GA - 5/15/2017 —The 12th Infantry Regiment Chapter of the 4th Infantry Division Association will hold a **monument dedication ceremony at 1 p.m. May 31**, at the National Infantry Museum's "Walk of Honor," Fort Benning, Ga.

SGM (Ret) Larry Walter, Honorary Sergeant Major of the 12th Infantry Regiment, will be the guest speaker. Also attending will be representatives of the two active duty battalions, the 1st Battalion and 2nd Battalion, 12th Infantry Regiment, and veterans and family members of the regiment.

This tribute to the infantryman honors our proud history and serves as a perpetual reminder of the sacrifices made by the infantrymen of the 12th Infantry Regiment to protect and preserve freedom for Americans and people around the world. The monument celebrates the contributions of the infantrymen in military campaigns in the United States and abroad – the War of 1812, the Mexican Wars, the Civil War, the War with Spain, the Philippine Insurrection, World War II, the Vietnam War, and the Global War on Terrorism in Iraq and Afghanistan. The names of the seven Medal of Honor recipients of the 12th Infantry Regiment are etched in granite. The monument will be a welcoming place for visitors who come to the National Infantry Museum to reflect on the glorious legacy of the 12th Infantry Regiment.
