Task Organization: No Change

1. (C) Situation:

a. Enemy forces: Annex A Intelligence

b. Friendly forces:

(1) 2d Bde continues Operation Putnam Wildcat in AO.

(2) 11th Bde conducts joint US/ARVN Operation Iron Mountain II in conjunction with 4th ARVN Regt.

c. Attachments and Detachments: C-1/22 effective 03 Jan 70.

d. Assumptions: 2d Bde will commit one company of 1/22 as in the event reinforcement.

2. (C) Mission:

Bn conducts a search and destroy operation utilizing the Recon Plat and two companies beginning 03 Jan 70.

3. (C) Execution:

a. Concept of operations: Annex B Operation overlay. Bn conducts (3) air assaults with C-1/22 into LZ vic BS677255; D-1/12 into an LZ vic BS697227 and the Bn Recon Plat into an LZ vic BS675222. A (10) min prep will be fired on each LZ prior to insertion. Priority of fires initially to C-1/22. Annex C, Fire support.

b. Co A

c. Co B airlifts one plat to D Co PB vic BS729221 on 02 Jan 70. Provides PB security until operation complete.

d. Co C establishes no more than (2) ambushes and remains on stand-by status, (1H alert), until operation complete.

e. CoD air assaults from BS729221 into LZ at BS697227. After insertion conducts RIF as directed. Day (1) objective BS694237; day (2) objective BS694228.

f. C-1/22 air assaults from BS \_\_\_\_\_ into LZ at BS677255. After insertion conducts RIF operation as directed; day (1) objective BS686240, day (2) objective BS686226.

g. Recon Plat: Air assaults from FSB TAPE into LZ vic BS 676222. Conducts RIF on designated route. Day (1) objective BS677228, day (2) objective BS686226.

h. Heavy Mortar Platoon: GS

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i. Coordinating Instructions:

- (1) ACL for UH-1 aircraft (6) PAX
- (2) Aircraft resources
  - a. (8) slicks, (4) gunships, (1) CC ship.
- (3) Anticipated duration of operation 4 days.
- (4) All elements will carry as a minimum (3) days rations, CLI, CLV.
- (5) Each individual will also carry 20 sandbags.
- (6) Each Co element will carry a minimum of (6) axes and enough D handle shovels/entrenching tools for every other man.
- (7) Each Co element will have (2) engineers attached with sufficient C-4 to cut emergency LZ's and/or bunker destruction as necessary.

4. (C) Administration and Logistics

- a. Resupply by helicopter, all classes.
- b. Medevac: Normal Dustoff SOP, freq 46.90.

5. (C) Command and Signal:

- a. Signal: Current SOI in effect, Index 50B-1, pg 2.
- b. Bn Command B will be the CC frequency.
- c. TAC CP located with C-1/22, initially LZ, BS677255.


