1. (C) SITUATION:

Enemy Forces: Current INTSUM

- B. Friendly Forces: 2d Bde continues operation Putnam Paragon with three Inf Bn's in assigned AO north of CAMP RADCLIFF and extends operations on D-Day to E-NE and initiates operations to locate and interdict locations of the 3d NVA Div vic SUOI KON River Valley. TF NAVAJO continues operations in AO Sprite and prepares to move to AP Pabst at 151100H Jun 70.
- C. Attachments and Detachments: See Task Organization.

2. (C) MISSION:
TF NAVAJO conducts multiple CA fo new FSB(BR356710) and conducts combat openperations in AO Pabst.

3. (C) EXECUTION:

A. Concept of Operations: TF NAVAJO moves to AO Pabst in two stages. During stage #1, Co A supported by a mini-dozer and engineers with demolitions, CA to new FSB on 15 Jun, and clear and secure area for aerial operations involving remainder of FSB elements, TAC CP will accompany Co A. Stage #2 will start on 16 Jun and will entail the movement of the remainder of the Bn to the FSB and field locations.

B. Co A: Move at first light on 15 Jun to FSB CHEYENNE. Upon arrival CA to new FSB on order. Upon completion of CA, and with the assistance of Eng personnel, clear new FSB for the insertion of remainder of FSB elements.

Secure area and assume mission of FSB security.

C. Co B: CA from FSB CHEYENNE to LZ vic BR390790, and conduct Search and Destroy operations in assigned AO.

D. Co C: CA from PZ vic BR112765, to LZ vic BR370667, and conduct operations in assigned AO.

E. Co D: CA from PZ vic BR123811 to new FSB and conduct Search and Destroy operations in assigned AO.

F. Recon Plat: CA from FSB CHEYENNE to new FSB. Upon arrival move to assigned AO and conduct RIF operations in assigned AO.

G. Heavy Mortar Plat: Airlift from FSB CHEYENNE to new FSB. Upon arrival be prepared to support Search and Destroy operations in AO Pabst.

H. B-4/42nd: Airlift from FSB CHEYENNE to new FSB. When established, provide general support for TF NAVAJO. Priority of fires to troops in contact.

I. 2-3/C 4th Eng: accompany fire base security company (Co A), to new FSB.

Upon arrival, support clearing operations. Priority: Clearing of pads VALS
and fields of fire.
