- 1.(C) Operations Summary
- A. The 1/12 Inf cont opn PUTNAM SHARK, N of CAMP RADCLIEF.
- (1) A Go conducts ambush operations on trail network in area of operations bounded by checkpoints 480890, 480870, 500870, 500890. 2/A at 485878 found junction; N-S trail 2' wide, E-W trail 2' wide; neither visible from air.

  A small bridge 4' long cross a revine in area of junction; approx 1 mo old.
- (2) B Co conducts FSB security and construction and maintains three ambiashes conducts a platoon size patrol generally along 527824, 536830, 535836, 529835, 522828 and returns to FSB. Neg significant sightings or contacts.
- (3) C Co cont amb operations on trail network in area of interest bounded by checkpoints 480860, 480840, 500840, 500860. 2/C at 485841 found 2 bunkers 8x10x5° and 2x4x4°, each with 18° 0/H; approx 1 month old, neg recent use. 2/C at 485841 found a 1½° trail running SW; not visible from the air; used within the last 3-4 days. At 494841 2/C found a 5° long bridge made of logs 6° in diameter with a handrail. Bridge constructed 6 mo to 1 year ago, barefoot prints on the bridge. There are 4 1° wide trails in the area, not visible from the air, Two run West, two run South, one trail in each set used in the last week. 1/C amb at 483848, found 30 bunkers, 2x3x4° with 2° 0/H, and 30 hootches, 4x4x4°, made of grass and sticks used 2-3 weeks ago. 3/C at 494855 found a hootch, 8x10x3°, 3° off the ground containing a cross-bow, also 2 trails 1° wide running N-S and E-W not visible from the air; used by 2-3 indiv in the last week.
  - (4) D Co continues to conduct training cycle at CAMP RADCLIFF.

(5) Recon maintains three ambushes in area bounded by checkpoints 524863 524850, 537850, 532863. At 531847 Recon found a 2 man fighter bunker, (4' deep with a tunnel to the left, nearby was another partially completed bunker of the same type. Wood chopping was heard 300m north. The area of the has had been used that morning. Vic of 533846 Recon found a cleared area with old campfires, less then 1 week old and a trail 2' wide running NW to SE.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.
