C Co in exploiting the cache found by R-18, (LRRP), at 493637 uncovered 24 82mm rounds; 9 60mm rounds; 9 fuses and 3 cans of machine gun links. 2/C vic 494638 found a second cache containing 6 82mm rds; 35 81mm rds of foreign make; 3 57mm RR rnds; 9 B40 rnds and 5 charges. 1 B 41
