SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 107 for 170001H to 172400H February 1970.

- 1. (C) Operations Summary
 - A. The 1/12 Inf cont opn PUTNAM SHARK, NW of Camp RADCLIFF.
 - (1) A Co conducts CA from PZ at BR308546 into an LZ at BR521692 and begins RIF oriented to the NE. 1/A ambush at 307548, found 60 lbs of coarse rice in a hootch 5x7x4'; both were destroyed. A Co at 527701 found a 1 man lem-to about 6' acdross containing 3 baskets, 3 wooden boxes, (18x12x10'); items were at least 2-3 weeks old. A Co found a well used trail running E-W at 524704, 12-15" wide; containing and set of bare footprints going E, estimate 2-3 days old.
 - (2) B Co conducts CA from PZ at 352574 into vic 557704, and then begins a RIF to the NE. Neg significant sightings or contacts.
 - (3) C Co conducts CA from FSB WARRICR to ESB TOUGHIE, and begins RIF the SE. C Cool reports movement 100m out at FSB TOUGHIE to the NE, also reports dog alerted.
 - (4) D Co secures TOUGHIE and maintains LP's and local security sweeps, mg sightings or contacts.
- (5) Recon conducts CA from 334540 to TOUGHIE, and begins RIF to the NE. Recon located 2 aerial booby traps at 546680 and 546682, strung to a tree; approx the size of baseballs.
- B. Cumulative total of all opns of all units since 25 Sept 70.

SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 108 for 180001H to 182400H February 1970

- 1. (C) Operations Summary
- A. The 1/12 Inf cont opn PUTNAM SHARK, NW of Gamp RADCLIFF.
- (1) A Co conducts RIF in area of interest bounded by checkpoints 528710, 54370, 543700, 528700. 2/A at 528706 located 15 huts, (12x10x12') all partially destroyed by R/L WP approx 1 month ago; 3 of the huts had false floors, 3 feet winder which were bunkers 4x4x4', 1' 0/H, used by approx 50 people.
- (2) B Co conducts RIF in area of interest bounded by checkpoints 563710, 577700,577700 563700 and establishes night ambushes. 1/B at 568705 found a 1 man sleeping position (5x2'), 2-3 weeks old with a campfire nearby; estimate 1 individual use the area. 1/B vic of 569706 walked into an area containing many punji stakes, 6 mo to 1 year old. One EM was injured by 1 stake.
- (3) Co conducts RIF along checkpoints 558689, 558675, 555670. At 554677 2¢ received S/A fire from 20m S, resulting in 5 US non-critical WIA. D Co reported several of the enemy rounds were hitting FSB TOUGHIE, G/S reported ground to air fire during their gun runs, they also reported observing a large structure 200m W of TOUGHIE. C Co at 554676 located 2 intersecting trails running of AZ's of 140° and 240°; they were 2' wide and not visible from the air. At 556674 the point element of C Co spoted 2 indiv 50m to their front, R/L was employed and the area was swept with neg results. Vic 554675 C Co found what appeared to be an old village and 10 bunkers; the lumber was beginning to rot.
- (4) D Co secures the fire base and conducts dealy security sweeps and ambushes, primary mission is fire b se construction, Report neg significant sightings of contact.

- (5) Recom conducts RIF along the checkpoints 553690, 556689, 557686 and establishes night ambushes. Neg significant sightings or contact reported.



SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 109 for 190001H to 192400H February 1970

- 1. (C) Operations Summary
- A. The 1/12 Inf cont opn PUTNAM SHARK, North of Camp RADCLIFF.
- (1) A Co cont RIF in area of interest bounded by checkpoints 528720, 54420 528710, 528710, and establishes 3 night ambushes. 2/A vic 544717 found 4 Montagnard type of hootches, 1 mo old; smallest 4x4x6', a 1 man sleeper; largest 8x10x12', large enough for 5; 9 rice cutters were found in the hootches, hootches were destroyed. A Co at 5337714 found 6 small amimal typaps approx 1 wk old; destroyed
- (2) B Co cont RIF in area bounded by 560730, 570730, 570710, 560710, and establishes 2 night ambushes. At 560712 the point man for the 1/B element hurt his left leg when he steped on a punji stake. Near by were 6 NVA Tunkers, 6x4x4', 6" C/H, very crude, 4 mo cld, used by 10 indiv; the area included a latrine; the bunkers were destroyed. Vic 566714, B Co took 3-4 rds of 3/A sniper fire with neg casualties; believed to have been 1 indiv. The SEL was 100m at an AZ of 50° to the above location. At the SEL 3/B found a fresh trail running NE, trail contained bootprints. 2/B vic of 566719 found 2 hootches 12x30' and 22x12', under the 1st wash bunker as large as the hootch; also found as a fenced in area 7x10' containing several picnic tables, possibily a mess hall; hootches were 8 mo old, last used 4 mo old, believed to be an NVA village. Across the river was a 3 foot wide trail. 2/P at 565724 found 1 hootch 4x5x7' about 3 mo old, used by 2-3 indiv in the last 3 mo; hootch destroyed. At 566714 an LPposition of B Co heard movement 50m away, sounded like 1 indiv walking; a frag was thrown and the movement ceased.

- (3) C Co cont RIF in area bounded by 550670, 564670, 564660, 550660. At 557663, 3/C found a trail 2' wide running due west; well worn, used recently by 3-4 indiv. At 556664, 3/C found 5 old and rotting hootches 10x12x22'; behind each was a bunker 4x5x10', 3 had 2' O/H, 2 were built in the side of a hill; neither had any recent use; nearby was atrail 2' wide which is not visible from the air; trails runs NE and wes used within last 48H by 3-4 indiv. While reconning by fire near 555604 3 indiv and a scout dog were injured by a short round from an 81mm mortar. 1/C vic 553659, discovered approx 300 fresh green punji stakes; also 2 punji pits each containing 20 old stakes.

 Near 559662 Hornet 11 observed 3 fairly new hootches, but were unable to check them out; there were many new punji stakes in vic 556663.
- (4) D Co secures TOUGHIE makes daily security sweeps and LP's; their primary mission is fire base construction. Report neg significant sightings.
- (5) Recon conducts RIF in area bounded by checkpoints 557690, 557680, 565680, 565690. At 555687 found 2 dud 500 lb bombs approx 2-3 mc old, serial #1325-935-9174 EOD requested.

SUBJECT: Daily SITREP 110 for 200001H to 202400H February 1970.

1. (C) Operations Summary

- A. The 1/12 Inf cont opn PUTNAM SHARK, north of Camp RADCLIFF.
- (1) A Co cont RIF in area bounded by 528730, 547720, 528720. At 545722 A Co discovered 1 trail 2' wide running N-S, not visible from the air, last used 2 days ago by 3-4 indiv. 3/A at 532720 found 3 hootches 20x15x10' last u 3-4 mo ago by an unknown number; destroyed. A Co(-) at 532729 found 1 high speed trail running off an AZ 220°, 18" wide not visible from the air, last used by 5 indiv 3 weeks ago.
- (2) B Co cont RIF in area bounded by 560723, 568734, 585734, 585723. At BR566714 2/B received 50 rds S/A fire from 75m on an AZ 50° from an est 2 indiv. 4.2" mortar was employed as a blocking force while the 2d plat moved into the 3%L. At 556714 1 B Co ZM sustained a punji stake wound in the right calve, he was evacuated by a re-supply slick. B Co at 565723, the point man opened fire with S/A on movement 75m to the NW, R/L employed, and a sweep of the area resulted in neg findings. At 565724 found a hootch,6x15x7' constructed of bamboo and 5 fighters 2x6' neg O/H, all were 6 mo old, (destroyed). Found 1 trail 2' wide not visible from the air, used by 3-4 indiv in the last 24H. 3/B at 567730 sighted a banana grove which was at 563737, they also heard chickens. At 1900H 3/B heard the chopping of wood.
- (3) C Co cont RIF in area bounded by checkpoints 548666, 563666, 563657, 548657. 3/C at 555663 had 1 EM who sustained a punji stake wound in the left

leg while on a RIF, At 553663 1 trail was found, running N-S, 2' wide, not visible from the air. It was last used by 6-8 indiv 48H before.

- (4) D Co maintains FSB security with 1 ambush, local security sweeps and LP's. At 0735H FSB TOUGHIE, (BR552681), took an estimated 30-40 rds S/A and MG fire from 75m out on an AZ of 80°. S/A, M-79, MG, and 81mm were returned on th SEL. 1/D swept the SEL with neg gindings.
- (5) Recon established 3 night ambushes in area bounded by 557670, 565690, 565678, 557678. The 1st sqd at 554686, while FSB was taking S/A fire requested to open fire on the SEL. Enemy was determined to be between Recon's position and the FSB. At0740H Recom(-) left the FSB to check area of SEL. At 554684 Recon(-) found 1 AK-47 rd in the SE..
