- (3) C Co remains in the area bounded by 360600, 394600, 360620, 394620, conducting S&E opns with neg findings.
 - (4)D Co remains at ARMAGEDDON, providing security for FSB and for Eng.
- (5) Recon cont to provide security of Hill 612. Second sqd RIF tic 392628 found a bootprint in a creek bed, 24H old. Also located PSP scattered from 396639 to 392630, believed to be broken sling load.
