1. Enemy: Elements of C2 407 Sepper Bn continue to operate in small 3-5 man teams. and continues to maintain surveillance of friendly units in AC ODIN.

2. Own Situation

a. Forward ele ents are mobile in AO ODIN. 1-12 Inf (TF NAVAJO) continues con PUTNAM PARAGON with Bn CP located at FSB UTE (BR356708).

b. Description and Results of Opns

(1) Co A cont S&C opns with small unit ambushes in AO bounded by: 410710, 440735, 410740, 440710. The sub element from 2/A vic 413747, spotted an indiv, initiated M-60 fire. R/L employed as a blocking fire, no return fire received. The indiv fled west, was pursued w/ neg findings. Indiv wore green clothing and carried an unidentified weapon. 2/A vic 419755 found a hootch and bun ker complex of 25 sleeping hootches, 8x1264', 3-4' 0/B and 3 bunkers 3x5x15' w/ 18" 0/H, 6 mo old. last use 3-4 days.

(2) Co B continued construction of FSB UTE and local RIF's.

(3) Co C remained OPCON to 2d Bde at FSB ARMAGEDDON, securing the perimeter

and engineers effort on QL 508.

(4) D Co remained in AO bounded by: 350600, 380600, 350630, 380630. Vic 362617, 1/D found a hootch 5x7x9', a bunker 3x7x3', last use 6 mos by 4 indiv, 1 year old. Vic 379610, 3/D found a bunker 10x2x51, V-shaped fighter w/ no 0/H, also 2 chickens, 5 mos old and no sign of recent use.

(5) Recon remained on Hill 612(BR399636) providing security for 81c(-) and

radio relay, conducting local RIF's and ambushes.
