- 1. (C) Operations Summary
- A. The 1/12th Inf cont opn PUTNAM PARAGON, from FSB CHEYENNE, BR102791.
- (1) A Co conducts CA to IZ vic 356708, and secures LZ, site of new FSB. At 1646H, final IZ, A Co chops to 2/35th Inf.
  - (2) B Co cont to maintain security of FSB CHEYENNE.
  - (3) C Co cont working in same are w/ ambush opns, neg contacts reported.
- (4) D Co secures downed ARVN aircraft until extraction and then began moving south. Vic 127816 2/D located a trail on 260°AZ, not visible by air. Trail well used and had been used in last 48-72 hrs. The trail ran parallel to a stream on the north side. Another trail was located 25m east of the above grid, 12" wide oriented on a 040°AZ, not visible by air and used in the past 2-3 days. A waterfall was found in the stream which had been used as a water point. There were 2 poncho hootch frames located there, 10x6x5' and 6x4x5'. Last use 2-3 days ago by 3-4 indiv.
  - (5) Recon cont to RIF to the SW of FSB with neg findings.

US losses: 50 WIA; 15 KIA.

Fdly losses: 1 KCS WIA.

US inflicted enemy losses: 22 enemy KIA, (BC); 3 VMC CIA; 24 S/A CIA; 16 satchel charges CIA; 3 radios, 4 field phones, 4 switchboards CIA; 1100 lbs salt and 150,800 lbs salt CIA; misc documents a d equip CIA.
