- 1. (C) Operations Summary
- A. The 1/12 cont opn PUTNAM SHARK, N of CAMP RADCLIFF.
- (1) A Co cont FSB construction and security; cnnsducts a daily sweep, and maintains an ambush vic 528824; neg significant sightings dr contacts.
- (2) B Co cont RIF in area of interest bunded by checkpoints 480810, 500810, 480790, 500790 and establishes night ambushes. 3/B at 496804 found a 3' wide trail which cannot be seen from the air, hardpacked with neg recent use. 2/B at 501798 discovered 3 hootches, 6x6x4', 7-8 months old, neg tecent use. 1/B at 496797 located the major trail of interest, hard packed trail which runs N-S, 6' wide and visibe from the air. Along the main trail 1/B found wood stacked in piles and a camouflaged tube, 5x2', made of wood with steel bands; inside were 19 (4" dia), tubes made of Siberglass, an aluminum plate was tacked to the outer frame. On/he same trail 1/B found a bridge, 5' wide, 6' long; made from 6" logs for frame and 2" logs for the flooring; rocket had partially destroyed the bridge. Nearby at 598794 the stream bank had been cleared and the ground covered with a clay, sand and water mixture.
- (3) C Co cant to RIF in area of interest bounded by checkpoints 490850, 510830, 510850, 490830 and establishes night ambushes. The KCS of 2/C reports a 3 company sized element had occupied the area around the hootchs at 497835, approximately 15 days agp; they moved to the west. At 497835 C Co received 25-30 rds of S/A fire from 2-3 individuals located to the SSW 50m; resulting in 1 US WIA. G/S received ground to air fire white

while expending on the SEL, from 500m W of this position; 4.2" employed on the second SEL. 3/C vic 496833 found 1 hootch, 10x10x5, containing 300 lbs rice, built and used 3 days ago by an undetermined number of people. In vic of 497832, 3/C found 2 bunkers, 4x6x4, with 1' 0/H and 3 hootches, 20x12x12' 5' bff the ground, two of the hootches had been used as slepers and the other for storage; 5-6 indiv had occupied these within past 24H. 1 and 3/C had 2-50 lb pigs wander in their night location at 497835, both died as a result of S/A wounds. 1/C found at 495835 a 2½' wide E-W trail not visible from the air; used by an unknown number of people in the past 22H. 3/C at 497832 found a 12" wide, E-WNW, high speed trail, not visible from the air with neg recent use. At 498834, 2/C found 2 hootches, 8x8x5', and 3 hootches, 4x6x5', used 2 weeks ago; the smaller hootches contained 3 cow bells, 4 SKS casingsaamd and a fish line. Nearby at 503833 2/C observed a gorge with 20 acres of potatoes and banans, neg recent cultivation.

- (4) D Co cont RIF in area bounded by checkpoints 531828, 542828, 535813, 547813, concentrates on the trail system and conducts night ambushes. 2/D amb at 503784 spotted 1 individual 25m away wearing black PJ's, no weapon wisible; indiv fled east when M-79 and S/A were employed.
- (5) Recon cont to RIF in area bounded by checkpoints 531828, 542828, 535813, 547813 ad conducts night ambushes. At 540820, the point man sighted and engaged one indiv carrying rucksack and weapon, 2 additional individuals were also observed carrying weapons. The individuals were wearing khaki shirts and 1 was wearing a GI helmet liner. While sweeping the SEL Recon

found 1 Montagnard basket, $2\frac{1}{2}x1\frac{1}{2}$ containing: 3° length of cloth with rice, GI sandbg of rice, (10 lbs), several small fruit baskets, tin pots and pans C-rat cans and accessory packs, 7 Chicom Mauser rds, one Chicom ammo pouch; vic 541820 a second basket, $12x10^n$, was found with: pots and pans, new pipe, fresh fruit, sheet of plastic, and GI helmet liner. Vic 542819 Recon found a blood trail running along blue line from west to east vic of previous engagement, will investigate in the morning.

- (1) A Co cont FSB security and construction and establishes an ambush vic 525824. Vic bunker 7 a trip flare went off, S/A employed, neg movement or fandings.
- (2) B Co continues to RIF and ambush in area of interest bounded by checkpoints 480810, 500810, 500810, 500790, 480790. Ambushes to be designated and oriented on major trail in area. At 495797, while working the major trail, B Co(-) found where 6" diameter trees had been cut and used to show the trail bed. The trail was hardpacked and barefoot and bootprints traveled east about 1 week ago; tire tracks were running bothe east and west. General trace of trail is 496797, 497797, 498794. At 495798 B Co(-) found a bridge 30m long, 5° above deep water; secondary trail intersect the main trail at bridge. This secondary trail runs NW-SE. Both tire tracks and footprints crossing the bridge were 1 week old. Next to the present structure was a partially destroyed structure, also a bridge. Wic of 495778 B Co found 3 hootches, 10x8x6', 6' off the ground, 2 w/ out walls, 6-9 months old; also 3 bunkers, 8x12x131, w/ 31 0/H and connecting tunnels. Inside the bunkers were 3 expended US smoke grenades; 3 bicycle rims; 1 front bicycle frame; 1 flashlight, NVA; parts of NVA ammo can, 2 C-ration cans, eaten 1 week ago; a "Standard Radio Corp" battery UM-2C-1.5V; 1 glass bottle, 4x2", with a wire filimentused as a lightbulb; 3 electrical blasting caps; and scraps of paper with Vietnames

writing. Area could house 30 indiv, last used 1 week ago by 3-4 indiv. At 495796 B Co(-) found 1 hootch, 8x8x12*, 3* off the ground, used by 2-3 indiv in the last week; hootch on a 12 wide trail, not visible from thear. Nearby was a hootch, 25x18x81, 61 off the ground; 6 mo old but used 3 weeks ago by 2-3 indiv. 3/B at 493799 found an E-W trail, branching off the main trail on AZ 310°, 12" wide, not visible from the air; used by 2-3 indiv in the last 24H. At 487797, 3/B found trail intersection, on an AZ 160°, 18" wide had one set of footprints heading S, 2-3 weeks old; the other was 6" wide, E-W, with no recent use; Neither was visible from the air. Vic 43799 2/B located a punji stake oriented NW in a tree, trail 4-5' wide at this point, est 1-2 indiv in area last week. Summary of Trails: main trail runs NW-SE along ridge line 498794 to 494798 then along AZ 310 to 495805, possibily from there to west vic 490805. Trail running south AZ 1600 from 487797 was definitely cut by NVA unt; undergrowth had been cleared, est 2 sqds. (16 indiv) did work.

- (3) C Co cont to amb in assigned AO, bounded by checkpoints 490850, 500850, 510830, 490830; ambushes oriented along trails. 3/C ambush at 496839 tokk 10 rds sniper fire AZ 60°, rng 75m, est 1 indiv, amb had just begun moving to the SE. 1/C at 493838 found 3 hootches, 8x10x5', 4' off the ground, est 6 months old, neg recent use; contained 2 banana knives, 3 sleeping mats and 2 baskets.
- (4) D Co cont to RIF S and W to locate major E-W trail then ambush on area of interest, center of mass 502775. At 503782 D Co found an 18" wide trail, E-W, not visible from the air neg recent use; near main trail was an NVA pouch that was not there yesterday. Vir of 504775

- A. The 1/12 Inf cont opn PUTNAM SHARK, N of CAMP RADCLIFF.
- (1) A Co cont FSB construction and security; also maintains three ambushs 517817, 544815, 523823, Reports neg significant sightings or contacts.
- (2) B Co cont RIF and ambush operations in area bounded by checkpoints 480810, 500810, 500790, 480890, oriented generally to the NW. 3/B at 488798 found a trail marker pointing to the south which directed them to a trail 1' wide running nowth to south, not visible from the air. The trail had had neg recent use. Beside this trail was a hollow tree with a gover that could have been used for storage, 6 months old. At 483799, 2/B found a 1½ wide trail running EW; much undergrowth, neg recent use; not visible from the air. 3/B vic 487798 found a 12' long, 8-10" wide bridge which had been partiallydestroyed, 6-8 months old with neg recent use. At 487799 3/B discovered an old hootch, 10x14x6', neg recent use. B Co at 487805 found 1 hootch, 6x8x5', 1' off the ground, and a fireplace 6-9 months old. Area appeared to have been used by 3-4 indiv in the last 24H, they departed on a 1' wide trail AZ 270°, not visible from the air. Old punji stakes were placed throughout the area in the trees waist high and on the ground.
- (3) C Co continues to ambush in area of interest bounded by checkpoints, 490850, 516850, 510830, 490830; oriented on trails in the AO. At 498836 3c/C ambush heard an est 5-6 indiv and received several rounds of S/A fire from 75m west. A scream was heard when they returned S/A fire. While maneuvering to sweep the SEL they found 1 KIA wearing khaki trousers, green

shirt and webb belt with 2 magazines and ammo; also 1 AK-47, (SN12051535).

1c/C ambush at 492837 observed and engaged 4 individuals on AZ 2550 and

180° at 20-30m, neg results. At 493826 1b/C amb observed 2 individuals 30-40m away and engaged with S/A. A sweep of the SEL revealed 1 KIA with AK-47 (SN2712), wearing green fatigues, webb belt, 2 US grenades and poncho, also found a heavy blood trail moving on an AZ of 300°. 1/C at 491839 detected movement, sounded like someone kicking a can, S/A employed, neg results.

- (4) D Co ambushes in present area of interest in morning and then moves to PZ vic 510765 for extraction to CAMP RADCLIFF. Rundown of bridges found so far: 25 Mar, 502776, 40' long 6' wide; 26 Mar, 498787, 30' long, 6' wide; 25 Mar, 504773, 15' long 6' wide; 25 Mar, 503771, 30' long, 6' wide. Trace of trail in 5076: 503771 to 505768 to 507768 to 510765. D Co at 504764 received 30 rds S/A fire at thier PZ, AZ 240°, rng 75-100m; est 2 indiv neg easualties; G/S expended.
- (5) Recon cont RIF and ambush operation in assigned area. At 546820 one ambush found a grave where the body had been exhumed, still contained a poncho, 2-3 days old.

Area est to have been occupied by 10-15 indiv at one time; the area contained: 1 NVA shitter; 4 old fighting positions; clothsline; chicken coop; 5x2' table; water buffalo hitching post; spider hole; and a second

trail intersecting the main trail, (following AZ 270°) going to the North.

- A. The 1/12 Inf cont opn PUTNAM SHARK, N of CAMP RADCLIER.
- (10 A Co conducts CA from FSB NIAGARA into an LZ vic 489872, and orients on the trail network in area of interest bounded by 480890, 500890, 500870, 400870 and establishes night ambushes. Neat the LZ in which A Co was inserted vic 487870, they found a 100' square banana grove and a 2 month old hooteh, 10x8x10"; the area was used by 2-3 indiv in the last month. At 486672 A Co found a 6x6x7' grain bin with 3-4" of rice on the floor, the entire bin with rice weighed 50-100 lbs.
- (2) B Co conducts CA from PZ vic 461814 into FSB NAAGARA, assumes FSB security, ambushes and sweeps. Neg significant sightings or contacts.
- (3) C Co conducts ambush operations in area of interest bounded by checkpoints 480860, 480840, 500860, 500840. 2 &3/C at 495845 found a hooteh, 10x8x51, approx 1 year old with neg recent use. The hootch contained a crossbow, some digging tools and old potatoes. 2/C at 483842 found 3 hootches, 8x10x61 21 off the ground, about 1 month old. They contained 15 rds AK/ SKS ammo, 1 cross bow, a bundle of 100 punji stakes and a small aid bag. Under 1 hootch was a bunker, 3x7x3' with 18" 0/H. Near by were 2 pig pens 8x15', at 3 chicken coops 3x4x3'. Area had been used within the last week. 2/C at 495844 found 1 hootch, 15x20x6', a 10x20' pig pen with 15 pigs, ranging from 50-100 les and a bunker 8x10x4' with 2' 0/H. Hootches contained 3 cross bows, 2 par black pants and 1 green shirt. Area used by 3-4 indiv in the past 24M. 1/C at 489847 found 7 hootches, 16x10x5' on 4' stilts, approx 1 year old, with mg DOWNGRADED AT 3 YEAR INTERONFIDENT

recent use. A scrap of paper was found with Vyetnamese writing which will be backhauled.

- (4) D Co conducts training cycle at Camp RADCLIFF and is Division reaction Co.
- (5) Recon conducts ambush operation in area of interest bounded by checkpoints 524863, 537836, 524850, 537850. At 524857 Recon found a 2' wide trail, NE-SW with punji stakes for 50m on either side; KCS identified stakes as being 2 days old. Found and disarmed 5'long spear type booby trap aimed chest high. In the same area Recon found numerous punji stakes and spring type booby traps, 1 man injured; area set up in last 2 days by 5-6 indiv. Trail was followed between 524857 and 522856, 2' wide and used within the last 48H; turns to the NW with many small branching trails which were camouflaged. Trees had been cut in half and bent over trails within the last 36H. Vic of 526857 Recon's ambush detected movement to the west and heard the chopping of wood. Indiv observed between the two ambushes wearing shorts and carrying a weapon, AZ 280° rng 75m, S/A employed.
