- (3) C Co left the FSBmoving to he NNW, finding 2 hootches; 4 sweatshirts; and 2 cutting knives.
 - (4) D Co was airlifted from LZ CASIS to FSB by Chinook and took offer FSB security.
- (5) Recon moved by air from LZ CASIS to he FSB, and moving north on a screening mission. Recon found vic 605455: 12 hootches; 5 sets fatigues, 2 green, 3 tiger; 2 sets web gear, 2 amo pouches; US belt; NVA shoes; 50 pigs; 200 chickens; ans 1 chicom gremade.
